

How to Research a Land Parcel Using Your Computer

On your computer,

- **Google** (or whatever you use to search the web)...
- **Type** "On-Line Maps Marathon County". Click to open page.
- On the [Marathon County Conservation Planning & Zoning](#) page, **scroll down** the page until you see the **Blue Box ...**"Terms..."
- **Double-Click** in box to accept terms.
- On the [Land Information Mapping System](#)" screen you'll see Marathon County towns in **purple outline**, and **above left top** the tabs **HOME, MAP, TOOLS** ; **select MAP**
- Under **MAP**, **select or click LAYER LIST**.
- *Click on LAYERS; see items appear under it.*
- *Click on boxes: DNR WETLAND POINTS, DNR WETLAND AREAS, FLOODPLAIN, COUNTY ZONING ZCR, HIGHWAY OVERLAY ZONING, SHORELAND OVERLAY ZONING.*
- Scroll back up to *I want to...* box near top left of map screen
- **Pa**nd click Drop down menu: "**Search by pin** (parcel identification #); or "**Search by address**"; or "**Search by owner**".
- Select which of above, type pin, address, or owner and click on **Search** box.
- Double-click on "**parcel (1)**

Resulting map will show the parcel, if there are wetlands, etc. You can print this for your records/info.

TO PRINT, click **HOME Tab**, select **Print icon**
