- Locations of "shoreland", floodplain, and wetland areas may be viewed on the Marathon County GIS Mapping Application. Locations of wetlands and wetland indicators may be viewed on the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Surface Water Data Viewer.
- Projects within "shorelands" and floodplains shall comply with the Marathon County Shoreland, Shoreland-Wetland, and Floodplain Code and may require permit(s)/approval(s) from Marathon County

Building & Site Plan Submittal Requirements:

- All floor plans
- At least two (2) building/structure elevation views

Site Plan, drawn to scale, is required which shall include the following (as applicable):

- Location of the project on the property
- Any existing or proposed structures or improvements on the property (e.g., buildings, structures, signs, driveways, parking/loading areas, ponds, etc.)
- Dimensions of any proposed improvements
- Setbacks of any proposed improvements on the property from property lines, roadways, wetlands, and surface waters (i.e., creeks, streams, rivers, ponds, and lakes)
- Any existing and proposed well and wastewater disposal system.
- Location and dimensions of all existing and proposed outdoor storage areas (if applicable)

SUPPLEMENTAL QUESTIONS FOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT

A conditional use permit applicant has the burden of proof. S/he must demonstrate that the application and all requirements and conditions established by the Town of Ringle relating to the conditional use are or shall be satisfied, all of which must be supported by substantial evidence. "Substantial evidence" means facts and information, other than merely personal preferences or speculation, directly pertaining to the requirements and conditions an applicant must meet to obtain a conditional use permit and that reasonable persons would accept in support of a conclusion.

If an applicant meets this burden of proof, the Town of Ringle will grant the conditional use permit. If an applicant fails to meet this burden of proof, the conditional use permit application will be denied.

To aid in its review of the proposed project, the Town will consider the Zoning Code of the Town of Ringle criteria set forth below. Answer all portions of all questions completely. State "not applicable," if appropriate, offering an explanation as to why facts and information were not provided.
