MC Landfill Smell Reporting - Do you ever smell the landfill? We need your help to get a good record of odor reports. Please be sure you know what you are smelling before sending in a report. Is the smell from a neighbor getting a holding tank pumped, manure or fertilizer getting spread on a nearby field, a gas leak nearby? Identify yourself by name, tell the location/address of the odor, the time and indicate the strength of the odor – very strong, strong, medium, or light. Email this information using **Landfill Smell** in the subject line, directly to the town at ringle446@gmail.com. A copy will automatically get sent to the MC Solid Waste. We will then have a hard copy of your report. It will just take a few minutes to do. The information will be very helpful to the Town.

GARBAGE AND RECYCLING: Garbage pick up is curbside every Friday. Recyclables are picked up every other Friday. **Recycle, Reduce and Reuse!** The pickup schedule is posted on the Ringle website.

YARD WASTE can be taken to Fraaza Rocks & Sand located on Ringle Ave. This is for yard waste only. Do not leave your plastic bags there. Please leave the site clean.

FIRE DEPARTMENT: Dial **911** for all emergency Fire and Ambulance calls. Dial 715-261-1200 for all non-emergency calls. We have a well trained and equipped Fire Department that will respond to your emergency calls. A big THANK YOU to the Ringle Fire Fighters and First Responders for their continued dedication to the Fire Department. **For an emergency**, you are located by your address. **It is very important** that you not move your Address Sign and to keep it very visible from the road. Clear away any brush or tall grass. Go out and check it today.

Burning permits are required in the Town of Ringle. Call 1-888-WIS-BURN (947-2876) or visit the DNR website before you burn. It is your responsibility to know if or when you can burn. Check it out before you burn.

FIREWORKS PERMIT: A permit is required in the Town of Ringle to shoot off fireworks. Contact the Town Chairman for a permit. Plan ahead! There is a 3-day waiting period.

LANDFILL USE: For Town of Ringle Residents only: the following items can be recycled **at no charge** at the Marathon County landfill, limited to the amounts per household per year as stated below: 8 light truck/automotive tires; 2 electronic devices (TV, pc, laptop, printer, monitor, DVD player, VCR, games systems); 2 household appliances (stove, dishwasher, refrigerator, air conditioner, microwave, furnace, dehumidifier); 10 fluorescent light bulbs; waste oil, lead acid batteries. **You will need proof of residency.**

Possible Major Road Projects this year will be reconstruction of a bad section of River Road near the school.

Spring Clean-up has been scheduled for May 13, 2023, 8am – 11am. Watch your mail for a post card. New location this year. It will be held at the Marathon County Landfill on Hwy 29.

ROAD WEIGHT LIMITS are now posted. Please adhere to these postings so our roads don't get ruined by heavy vehicle traffic.

BUILDING PERMITS: are required in the Town of Ringle. Contact Leon Falkowski for building and zoning questions. The zoning map, ordinances and permit applications are posted on the Town's website. You must obtain a permit **before** you start to build. Please plan ahead and get your permit before starting your project.

HALL RENTAL FEES: Rental Fees - \$75 if any alcohol is served. \$50 when alcohol is not served. Plus, a \$50 refundable security deposit. Contact the Clerk at 715-571-6669 or ringle446@gmail.com to rent the hall.

U.S. Flag Disposal: Contact a member of the local VFW to properly dispose of your U.S. flags.
