### Town of Ringle Utility Permit Provisions and Conditions of Issuance

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 60.22, 66.0425, 86.07, 86.16, 86.021, & 349.13, this permit is granted to allow performance only of the specific work described herein. The following standard provisions and any included special provisions shall govern:

- The Applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Town of Ringle, its employees and its agents, from any
  cost, claim, suit, liability and/or award which might come, be brought, or be assessed, because of the issuance or
  exercise of this permit, or because of any adverse effect upon any person or property which is attributed to the
  partially or entirely completed works of the Applicant. Accomplishment of the permitted work, or any part
  thereof, by or on behalf of the applicant shall bind such Applicant to abide by this permit and all its conditions
  and provisions.
- 2. The permitted facilities shall, if necessary, be altered at the expense of the Applicant to permit alteration, improvement, or maintenance of the highway as may hereafter be ordered. The entire cost of constructing and maintaining the permitted facilities shall be the obligation of the Applicant unless a contract for such costs has been executed with the Town of Ringle.
- 3. No open cutting for a crossing will be allowed where the pavement is too narrow to maintain one-way traffic at all times, unless the Town of Ringle has granted permission for a detour. Wherever the pavement is opened, the spoil shall be hauled away and the trench shall be backfilled with sand or gravel and compacted in layers. The pavement removed for a road crossing shall be replaced as per the Town of Ringle specifications.
- 4. When one- way traffic or a detour is used, the Applicant shall provide ALL NECESSARY SIGNS, FLAGMEN AND LIGHTS required according to the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices". When a detour is allowed, local newspapers shall be notified by the Applicant in advance of the work being started.
- 5. All disturbed areas shall be returned at a minimum to their present condition, subject to the satisfaction of the Town of Ringle or its representative. All debris, refuse and waste resulting from a utility activity, including any natural materials that are disturbed or cut, must be removed from the site. Any curb, gutter, pavement, sidewalk, driveway, gravel base, ballast, shouldering material, or blacktop or other element disturbed by the utility shall be restored to the qualities, grades, compactions, conditions, to at a minimum match the existing condition. Any turfed area disturbed by the utility shall be restored with topsoil to the depth that existed prior to construction and reseeded to similar perennial grass or sodded. The utility shall be responsible for restoring the disrupted surface to its original condition (as close as possible) by the permit completion date. Exceptions may be allowed (e.g. in the case of bad weather) with prior approval from the Town. Failure of the utility to make prompt and satisfactory restorations of the property may cause the Town to arrange for restoration by others at the utility's expense and will prevent any further issuance of permits for succeeding applications.
- 6. Any trenching, tunneling, or excavating shall be performed in accordance with the requirements of OSHA and the Wisconsin Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations, and any applicable local regulations.
- 7. A copy of this approval, along with any plans and special provisions, shall be available on the job site.
- 8. Upon completion of the work the Applicant shall file a written notice with the Town of Ringle.
