Marathon County Landfill Smell Reporting - Do you ever smell or hear noise from the landfill? We need your help to get a good record of odor/noise reports. To report the smell or noise, identify yourself by name, tell the location/address of the odor/noise, the time and indicate the strength of the odor/noise – very strong, strong, medium, or light. Email this information using **Landfill Smell** in the subject line, directly to the town at ringle446@gmail.com. A copy will automatically get sent to the MC Solid Waste. We will then have a hard copy of your report. The information will be very useful to the Town.

GARBAGE AND RECYCLING: Garbage pick up is curbside every Friday. Recyclables are picked up every other Friday. **Recycle, Reduce and Reuse!** The pickup schedule is posted on the Ringle website.

YARD WASTE can be taken to Fraaza Rocks & Sand located on Ringle Ave. This is for yard waste only. Do not leave your plastic bags there. Please leave the site clean.

FIRE DEPARTMENT: Dial **911** for all emergency Fire and Ambulance calls. Dial 715-261-1200 for all non-emergency calls. We have a well trained and equipped Fire Department that will respond to your emergency calls. A big THANK YOU to the Ringle Fire Fighters and First Responders for their continued dedication to the Fire Department. **It is very important** that you not move your Fire Sign and to keep it very visible from the road. Clear away any brush or tall grass. **Burning permits** are required. Call 1-888-WIS-BURN (947-2876) or visit the DNR website before you burn. It is your responsibility to know if you can burn.

BUILDING PERMITS: are required in the Town of Ringle. Contact Leon Falkowski for building and zoning questions. The zoning map, ordinances and permit applications are posted on the Town's website. You must obtain a permit **before** you start to build.

HALL RENTAL FEES: Rental Fees - \$100/day, plus, a \$100/day refundable security deposit. Contact the Clerk at 715-571-6669 or ringle446@gmail.com to rent the hall.

U.S. FLAG DISPOSAL: Contact a member of the local VFW to properly dispose of your U.S. flags.

DOG LICENSES are due April 1st. Contact our Town Treasurer for license information.

****New this Year **SPRING CLEAN-UP **** As an added benefit to the residents of Ringle, the Marathon County Solid Waste Department has worked with the Town to plan the 2025 Spring Clean-up during the entire month of May during normal operating hours of the landfill. This provides flexibility for residents to deliver materials and saves both Town and County resources. Ringle Residents may bring bulk item waste and recycling materials directly to the Solid Waste Department. Residents must provide proof of residency upon arrival. Solid Waste staff will keep track and provide a record of residents who participate. This arrangement **does not** extend to any **business, landowner, or agricultural operation** – households only.

Ringle Town Residents may bring the following at no charge (Limits per Household)

MAY ONLY 1 delivery per year of bulk item waste (1200 lb. limit – additional weight charged at per ton rate)

JAN-DEC

8 Tires, 2 electronic devices, 2 household appliances, 10 fluorescent bulbs, Waste Oil, Batteries, Household Hazardous Waste

Curbside waste will continue to be accepted at no charge from the commercial hauler (Harter's). Loads must be secured or covered during transport. All waste must be unloaded by hand upon delivery.

Landfill Hours 7am to 3pm Monday- Friday and Saturday 8am to 11:30am April-November
