

RESOLUTION NO. 2026- 01**TOWN BOARD RESOLUTION FOR RELIEF FROM LANDFILL
TIPPING FEE DUE TO SEVERE WEATHER EVENT AND TORNADO**

WHEREAS, the Marathon County Solid Waste Department, including the landfill, is located in the Town of Ringle ("Town") at 172900 State Hwy 29; and

WHEREAS, the Town receives a portion of the tipping fee in the amount of \$2.33 per ton when waste is deposited into the landfill; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Governor Tony Evers issued Executive Order no. 289 on April 15, 2026 "Declaring a State of Emergency in Response to Flooding and Severe Weather Impacts" throughout the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, on Friday April 17, 2026, the local area experienced a severe weather event, including an EF-3 scale tornado that touched down within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the severe weather event, and particularly the tornado, caused extensive damage to the area; and

WHEREAS, cleanup efforts related to this severe weather event and tornado will necessarily result in large amounts of waste to be deposited into the landfill; and

WHEREAS, the Town recognizes the hardship created for residents due to this severe weather event and tornado;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board hereby resolves that the Town will forego its \$2.33 portion of the landfill tipping fee for the deposit of any debris from Marathon, Shawano, and Portage Counties caused by the severe weather event and tornado until June 17, 2026.
